***The Role of Nonprofits Under the
Affordable Care Act***

The Section on Nonprofit and Philanthropy Law is issuing a call for proposals for its session on the role of nonprofit organizations under the Affordable Care Act of 2010 ("ACA"). The panel, co-sponsored by the AALS Section on Law, Medicine and Health Care, will be held on Friday, January 3, 2014, from 10:30 a.m. to 1:15 p.m., at the AALS 2014 Annual Meeting in New York, New York. Presentations might address the ACA's impact on nonprofit and other tax-exempt organizations; the ACA's new requirements for 501(c)(3) tax-exempt hospitals; the participation of tax-exempt hospitals in Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs); and nonprofit Consumer Operated and Oriented Plans (CO-OPs).

Panelists will be a mix of presenters chosen through this call for proposals and solicited panelists with relevant expertise. Presenters will have the opportunity to publish their papers in the *Indiana Health Law Review*.
